NEW CHAIRMAN OF AUSTRALASIAN GAMING COUNCIL

The Australasian Gaming Council (AGC) has appointed a new Chairman – Mr Peter Burnett.

Mr Burnett has served on the Board of the AGC for five years and he brings substantial knowledge of the hotel and gaming industries to this important role.
